

Neighbourhood Plan Referendum for the Bramham Neighbourhood area

1. A referendum will be held on **Thursday 14 February 2019** to decide on the question below:

“Do you want Leeds City Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Bramham to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”
2. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, Level 2, Town Hall, The Headrow, Leeds LS1 3AD** by **midnight on Tuesday 29 January 2019**.
3. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, Level 2, Town Hall, The Headrow, Leeds LS1 3AD** by **5pm on Wednesday 30 January 2019**.
4. Applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, Level 2, Town Hall, The Headrow, Leeds LS1 3AD** by **5pm on Wednesday 6 February 2019**.
5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, Level 2, Town Hall, The Headrow, Leeds LS1 3AD** by **5pm on Thursday 14 February 2019**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 6 February 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 6 February 2019.
